PCS WIRELESS TO PROVIDE MOTOROLA WITH DISTRIBUTED ANTENNA ARRAY EQUIPMENT FOR PCS NETWORKS

Vancouver, B.C. - March 8, 1995. PCS Wireless, Inc. today announced an agreement with Motorola Cellular Infrastructure Group (CIG) that enables CIG to offer PCS Wireless products to Personal Communications Services (PCS) operators in the United States.

Under the agreement, PCS Wireless, based in Vancouver, British Columbia, will supply Motorola with its Remote Antenna Driver/Remote Antenna Signal Processor (RAD/RASP) equipment. RAD/RASP uses a distributed antenna system to convert existing cable infrastructure into a wireless network. Terms of the agreement were not disclosed.
