*Development of new Feature Phone reference designs to help speed time to market

3GSM World Congress, Barcelona, Spain – February 13, 2006 – Intrinsic Software International, Inc. Soleus is a turnkey development platform for feature phones that leverages the Microsoft® Windows™ CE operating system and Visual Studio development environment to create software that provides mobile phone manufacturers with more cost-effective and feature-laden handset design options. Attendees will be able to choose the look and feel of their phone design, make specific application and feature set choices, quickly compile and download the software to a reference design and then place and receive calls whilst manipulating various forms of media on the devices.
