PCS WIRELESS, INC. ANNOUNCES \$8.5 MILLION AGREEMENT WITH ERICSSON

Vancouver, B.C. - April 21, 1995. PCS Wireless, Inc. announced today that it has signed an agreement to supply Ericsson Inc. with Remote Antenna Driver (RAD) and Remote Antenna Signal Processor (RASP) products. The RAD/RASP concept allows PCS operators to transport PCS signals from centralized radio base stations via distributive antenna and Cable TV networks.

Ericsson has issued its initial purchase order for CDN \$8.5 Million in equipment for deliveries later this year. With the exercise of certain options, the supply contract could provide for up to CDN \$37 Million in equipment deliveries over a 15 month period.

“Ericsson has been a very important customer for us over the last year. They were early proponents of integrating GSM based DCS1900 wireless technology with our Platform RAD distributed antenna system for the U.S. market,” said Ralph Scobie, President & CEO, PCS Wireless.

“Ericsson recognizes the potential of providing personalized communications services via the CATV network infrastructure. PCS Wireless’ products are important in helping us obtain an entry into this important market,” said Robert Capps, Director of Strategic Accounts, Ericsson, Inc., Radio Systems.
